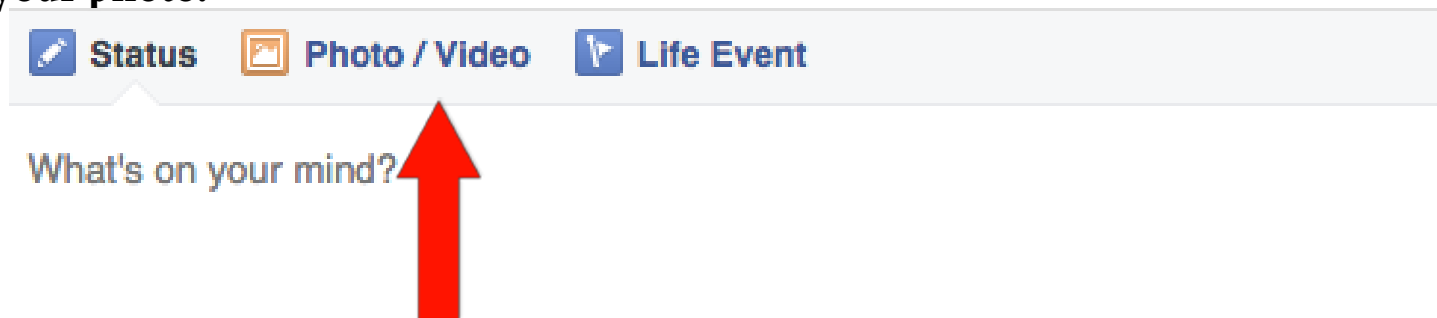
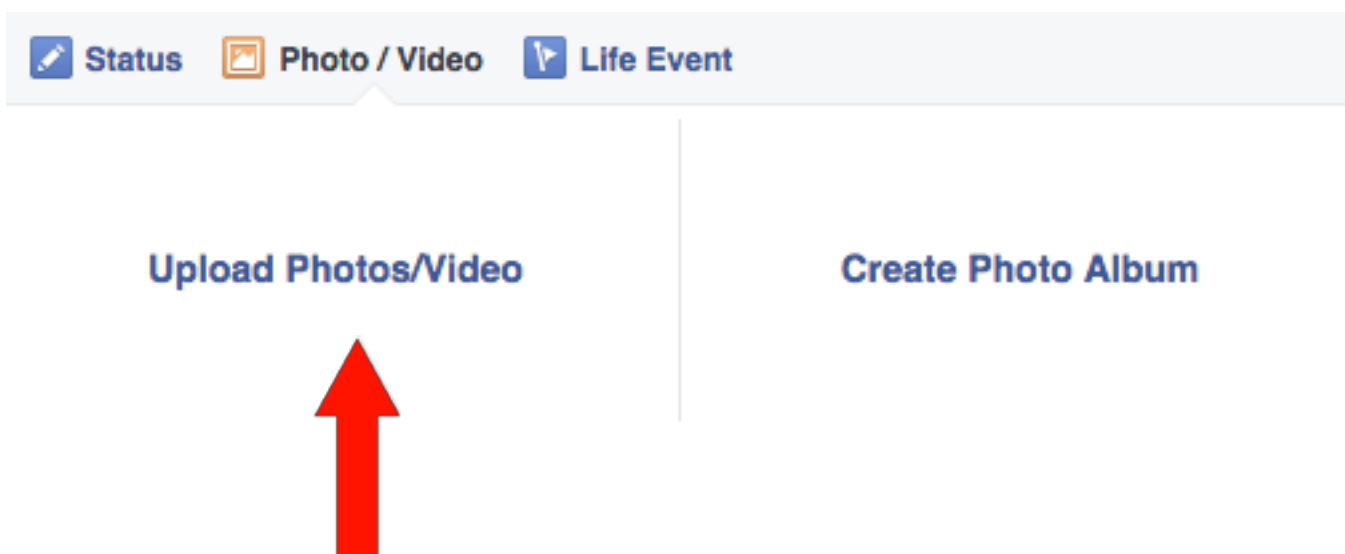


How to upload your photo and #winwithHDS

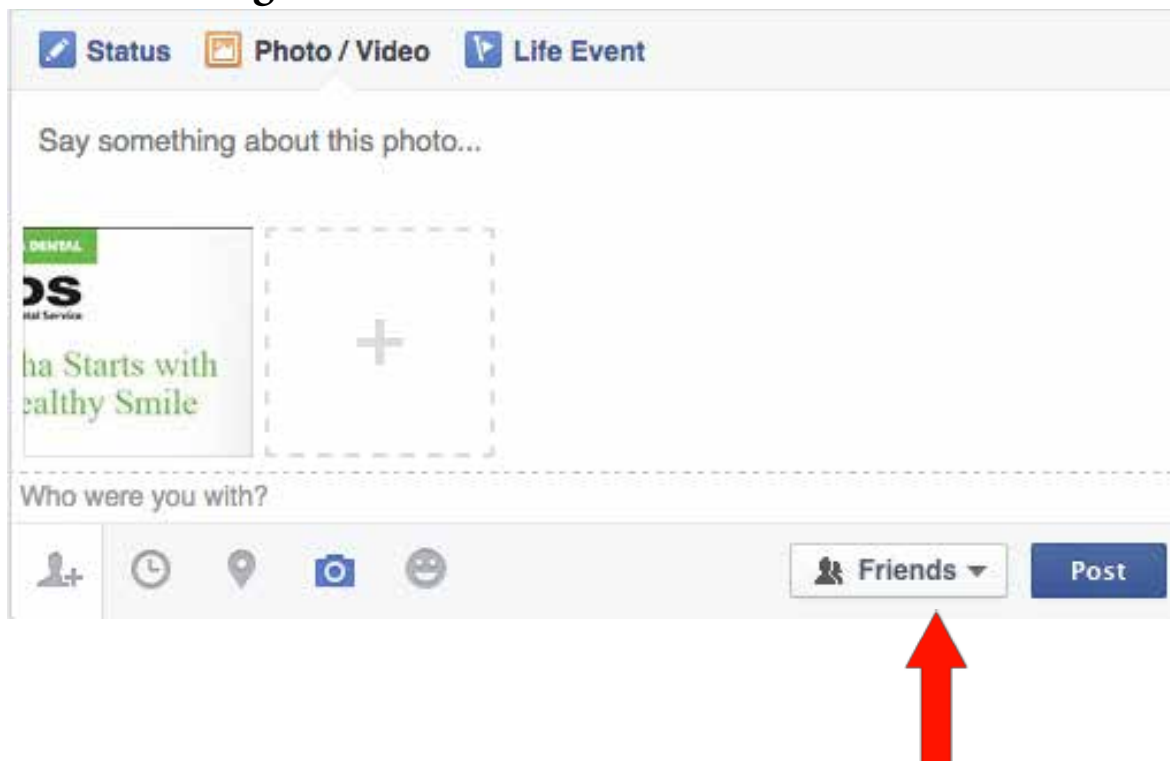
Step 1: Login to your personal Facebook account. Click Photo/Video to upload your photo.




Step 2: Click Upload Photos/Video. Then select your photo from your computer or phone.



Step 3- 4: Your photo has uploaded. Make sure to use #winwithHDS. Click “Friends” and change the selection to “Public.”


